Notes for Applicants

1. Family membership includes both spouses or partners and all children less than 18 years; both spouses or partners may vote at general meetings.
2. a. Applications will be brought before the Management Committee at its first meeting after receiving your application form. The names of applicants will then be posted on the notice board in the Club House and, providing no written objections have been received, the application will be confirmed at the next meeting. (These are usually held monthly)

b. While the application is pending, applicants are very welcome to visit the Club. On a Sunday lunchtime there is always an Officer of the Day on duty to answer any queries you may have and you would be most welcome at any club events including cruises. (Notes on cruising and rules should be read and adhered to.)
3. On acceptance, the Membership Secretary will write to confirm your membership and send your membership card and Club Handbook. This sets out the rules and objectives of the Club, lists current Club officers and Management Committee members and other personnel and also gives information on Club facilities, Bosun's Stores stock and prices, bar opening times, tide tables, emergency procedures etc. In addition, our newsletter 'On Watch' is sent out to all members monthly giving the latest update on matters concerning the Club and details of the social and cruising programmes. The club website www.woodbridgecruisingclub.co.uk also provides full details of the Club's programmes as well as other useful information.
4. Annual subscriptions become due on 1st January each year, but new members whose applications are approved after 1st October are not required to pay a further subscription the following year. Each member is issued annually with a membership card, on receipt of subscription in full, which is valid for that year only. Please have your card with you when visiting the Club and foreign or "away" Clubs as you may be asked to produce them.
